Focus in building effectiveness in Finnish traffic system

- Securing safety and transparency
- Support in emission reduction

Growth in net sales doesn't play a crucial role – growth possible when introducing new services.

Moderate profitability, EBT 3-5%, secures ability to upgrade digitalization of Finnish traffic system.

Pricing of the majority of the business follows Cost plus

Recent fluctuations in net sales and profitability in air navigation services are caused by the Covid pandemic and Ukrainian war



Modernization of Finnish Technological Infrastructure in Traffic Management reguires Investments

Major part of the investments are carried out in partnership with Finnish Transport Infrastructure Agency (Väylävirasto). Promoting digital layer into railway, road and maritime traffic management infrastructure means:


- Automation

- Data to support diverse end users


Significant CAPEX categories:

- Remote control systems
- Automation of traffic operators' duties
- · Facilities to provide data to traffic end users
- Tunnel technology

Significant capital expenditure program was carried out also in air navigation services during 2020-21 regardless of challenging time due to Covid. Recovery in cash flow expected in 2025.


Next generation's digital railway control system will be launched gradually after 2026 requiring significant investments and financing.








Amount of debt increases but Balance sheet remains strong








- Interest bearing debt will increase in the next couple of years due to the air traffic volume's hit on cash flow and group's steady capex volumes.
- Balance sheet remains strong with moderate net gearing levels and equity to asset ratio remaining stable at approx 60%.
- Next generation's digital railway control system will be launched gradually after 2026 requiring significant investments and financing. This may also offer new investment opportunities for the investors



Fintraffic's 100 million Commercial Paper Programme

- Fintraffic launched a 100 million euro commercial paper programme on 23rd of November 2022 in an investor presentation.
- The commercial paper programme will increase sources of funding and improve flexibility.
 It will be mainly used to finance short term financing needs.
- The programme will come on top of the current existing long term financing facilities consisting of term loan and revolving credit facilities.
- The arranging banks are OP (lead arranger), Nordea and SEB.
