FILLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRE-NOTIFICATION FORM

Advance notice should be done for a maximum of two weeks, unless otherwise agreed with AMC.

SECTION 1. Notification author

This section provides the contact information of the person who made the notification. If AMC has any questions about the information in the notification, AMC will contact the author.

SECTION 2. Area

The area number (e.g. EFD123) and the area name (e.g. TAMPERE) are entered in this section. If the area contains sub-parts, the sub-parts to be activated are entered in section 3.

SECTION 3. Activation times (Local Mean Time) and vertical limits

Operating hours should be reported as accurately as possible, to the hour. If a break of more than two hours is planned for the operation, this must be taken into account in the operating hours. Continuous operating hours (H24) should only be used if the operation does not have breaks of more than two hours or if planning breaks in advance is exceptionally difficult.

Column 'Activated area or its sub-part'

The column contains the number of the area /sub-part(s) (e.g. EFD123 or EFD124B). Several sub-parts can be entered on the same row, if all the information (dates, activation times and vertical limits) of the sub-parts is the same.

If the number of rows in the table are not sufficient for all the areas /sub-parts to be reported, the activity times and vertical limits can also be reported in a separate (freeform) appendix. In that case, mark on the first row of the table 'see appendix'.

Column 'Date(s)':

The column contains the date of operation (e.g. 24.06.2025) or the start and end date of the operation (e.g. 24.-30.06.2025). See also the examples in the Note section.

Column 'Activation times'

The column contains the activation times for the day in question (e.g. 0800-1600). See also the examples in the Note section.

Note 1. Activations times are the same every day.:

Note 2. Activations times vary daily, mark the Activations times for different days:

SECTION 4. Type of activity

The section indicates the type of activity taking place in the reservation, e.g. UAV.

Note: The entry must correspond to the type of activity in the area publication (AIP or AIP Supplement).

SECTION 5. Other information

Any additional information is entered in this section.

SECTION 6. Contact details during the activation

This section contains the contact information of the person in charge of the operation and the possible secondary person, as well as the radio frequency and call sign if in use.

- In the case of permanent and temporary danger areas, the telephone number of the person in charge of the operation (and possible secondary person) will be published in the NOTAM activating the area. **The person in charge must be reachable at the phone number provided throughout the operating hours stated in the activation NOTAM.**
- In the case of permanent and temporary restricted areas, the telephone number of the person in charge of the operation (and possible secondary person) will not be published in the NOTAM activating the area, unless otherwise specified in the decision of Traficom. **If a phone number is published, the person in charge must be reachable at the phone number provided throughout the operating hours stated in the activation NOTAM.**
